Through multiple TEA-21 and TDEC-LPRF grant cycles, CCE has assisted the City of Brownsville, Tennessee in securing over \$480,000 in funding to transform 13-acres of low-lying cotton fields into a walking trail park. The park received the Tennessee Recreation and Parks Association's Four-Star Award for new facility construction. Park features include:

- Native tree plantings, benches, rose-covered trellises.
- A central gazebo.
- 4,590 l.f. of walking trails.
- Interpretive signage.
- A 3/4 acre recirculating water feature
